Project Summary

Background

Through participation in training courses, the project was to make the school more attractive, raise its profile in the region, meet the needs of the school and the expectations of teachers, pupils, parents and local authorities, reinforce the learning process and improve educational results.

The project addresses the school's needs in the following areas: communication in foreign languages, learning to learn, natural competences, IT skills, social awareness, civic awareness, behaviour in difficult situations (stress), fostering children's development, international cooperation. Based on a survey the topics for training and project activities were adjusted. The effectiveness of the activities is measured by the increased quality of general education in our school and the answer the challenges of the modern world.

Objectives

Undertaking an educational project was rooted in the identification of the key needs and challenges facing the school. Based on the analysis, the main project goals were determined.

Thanks to the project:

- -Pedagogues gained language competence, which enabled them to participate in specialized courses and job shadowing.
- -The activities contributed to the growth of teachers' self-confidence, improved their job satisfaction and introduced freshness and new quality in their activities.
- -The school's educational offerings were enriched, and a class with expanded English language, classes with CLIL, volleyball classes, classes that develop learning skills became available to students.
- -International cooperation with other European schools contributed to the effective introduction of novelties learned during the mobility into the curricular, educational and preventive programs. Especially job shadowing showed us new ways of teaching and looking at it.
- -Pupils became more aware Europeans, moved more confidently in the international arena and overcame language barriers thanks to fruitful international cooperation and cultural exchange.
- -The use of Internet resources in a foreign language was made possible, which was another success of the project.

Implementation

Teachers participated in 21 mobilities:18 training courses(4 language+14 specialised) and 3 job shadowing. The planned specialised and language courses covered the key competences defined in the European School Development Plan in accordance with the needs of the school:communication in a foreign language; learning to learn; natural competence; digital competence; social awareness; civic awareness; dealing with difficult situations (stress); supporting children's development; international cooperation.
